Our aims are to:

- Influence local and national government policy relating to nature
- Coordinate nature conservation delivery across the county
- Engage more people with the natural environment and the benefits it provides to their health and wellbeing
- Promote the economic benefits of a healthy natural environment.

What is nature doing for your business?

Studies show that living close to and having convenient access to natural green space improves health and wellbeing. Among others, it reduces stress, anxiety and heart disease. Studies also show that getting outside and enjoying the natural environment improves our general happiness and that happy workers are more engaged, attentive and productive.

Berkshire's natural environment is working for you, keeping your teams healthy, motivated and happy at work.

Materials

Many of our raw materials are obtained from the local natural environment, including construction aggregates, other minerals, wood fuel and timber.



→ Pollination

Many of our food crops require pollination by bees and other wild insects. This service has been estimated to be worth £691 million per year to the UK economy.



→ Health & Wellbeing

Green spaces provide opportunity for physical exercise and mental relaxation. Access to natural green space can help prevent heart disease, reduce stress and mental illness. Lack of exercise costs the UK economy £30bn per year and businesses pay a large chunk of that.



→ Water Regulation

Nature helps to regulate our water supply and cleans pollutants from drinking water. Trees and vegetation also help regulate and mitigate flood risk, as well as helping control our climate. Would your teams be as creative
